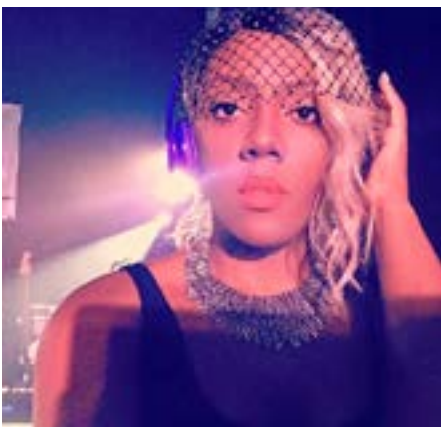


SIR DUKE FEATURING TONEIA RODGERS Saturday, September 9, 8:30pm-12:30am
